2. Because Trump Is Silencing Organized Workers

Trump rolled back rules protecting federal workers' rights to union representation, collective bargaining, and due process. Unions give workers the power to demand fair pay, safe conditions, and accountability.



Authoritarian regimes have long sought to weaken or destroy unions, because organized workers are a threat to unchecked power.

5. Because Trump Is Undermining Mothers and Caregivers

Trump's administration disrupted Head Start, a program that has supported over 40 million families with childcare, school readiness, and health services. Cuts and shutdowns have thrown many centers into chaos.



Without Head Start, many mothers can't work or study, robbing families of stability and women of financial independence.

7. Because Trump Is Taking Food Away From Children

Congressional Republicans, with Trump's support, pushed \$30 billion in cuts to nutrition programs, mainly SNAP, which feeds over 40 million Americans. These cuts target children, seniors and struggling workers while handing billions to the wealthy.



1. Because Trump Is Rigging the Economy Against Us



Trump is interfering with the Federal Reserve, pushing to fire independent officials and influence interest rates for political gain. Experts warn this could destabilize the economy.

When the Fed is politicized, working people pay the price through higher inflation and rising costs for housing, groceries, and everyday needs.

3. Because Trump Is Taking Away Our Work Safety

Trump's Labor Department proposed sweeping deregulations that gut protections around wages, civil rights, safety, retirement, and job training.



With fewer rules and less oversight, employers face no consequences for unsafe conditions, wage theft, or discrimination, leaving workers, especially women, with lower pay, more injuries, and fewer options.

6. Because Trump Is Destroying the Education System

Trump shifted \$51 billion into private school vouchers and slashed \$300 billion from public colleges. He increased how much borrowers owe on student loans and ended key protections.



Families face rising student debt, fewer affordable college options, and underfunded public schools, closing doors for the next generation.
